Attached is Westinghouse Hanford Company's (WHC) proposed Implementation Plan Revision One for resolving the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (DNFSB) Recommendation 93-5 (References 1 and 2). This Implementation Plan revision presents a modified approach to achieve the original Implementation Plan objectives.

This modified approach concentrates on actions necessary to assure that the waste in Hanford high level nuclear waste storage tanks can be safely stored and on obtaining timely characterization information for the tank waste Disposal Program.

This Implementation Plan revision has been developed by WHC with extensive interaction with both the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office and U.S. Department of Energy-Headquarters. The revision was extensively reviewed by senior WHC executives and consultants.

Some of the milestones contained in this revision are not yet supported by funded activities in the current Tank Waste Remediation System (TWRS) Multi-Year Program Plan. Change requests to fund these activities will be submitted to RL not later than March 31, 1996. Once the change requests are approved, these activities will be entered in the TWRS scheduling system to allow electronic, automatic tracking of their status.

This proposed Implementation Plan revision is forwarded with the intent of reaching formal, documented consensus on the path forward to resolving DNFSB Recommendation 93-5 actions.
