Bill Brumley was named Manager of the Y-12 Site Office in April 2000. He is responsible for national defense activities that are performed at the Y-12 National Security Complex, operated under the auspices of the National Nuclear Security Administration. These activities include the remanufacture, surveillance and assessment of weapons components, dismantlement and storage of highly enriched uranium, and the safe and secure storage of special nuclear materials.

Prior to taking this position, Mr. Brumley was the Acting Assistant Manager for Defense Programs for the Department of Energy's Oak Ridge Operations Office. Before arriving in Oak Ridge, he served as the Deputy Assistant Manager for National Security at the Savannah River Operations Office in Aiken, South Carolina. Prior to joining the Department of Energy in 1976, he was employed by the Department of Defense at the Charleston Naval Shipyard in Charleston, South Carolina.
